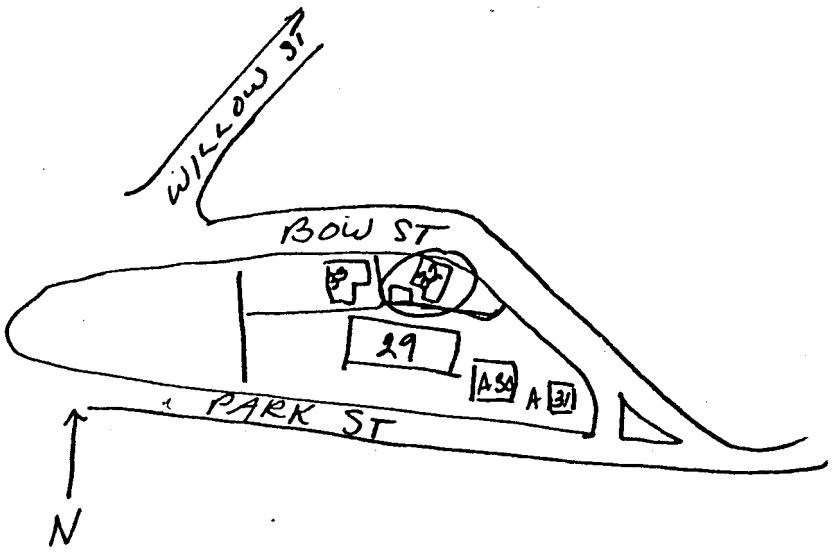

Harrison G. Hunt purchased the property in 1869. In 1880, he rented to Otis P. Symonds, millwright/box manufacturer. Hunt sold to Paschal A. Walls, grandson of Ebenezer Abbott, in 1907.

The home was probably used as income property almost from the time it was built until sold to the present owner in 1942.
